By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.61, dated 24.07.2014, registered under Sections 304-A, 304 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. The co-accused Rajbir Singh and Gursharanjjit Singh have already been admitted to regular bail by this Court. The petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2014.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the prayer of bail and states that the deceased was last seen in the

company of the petitioner. The challan stands presented; out of total 15 witnesses, only one witness has been examined so far.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Keeping in view the fact that the deceased was last seen in the company of the petitioner and the key role of the petitioner, no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
