Therefore, respondent nos.2 and 3 oppose the quashing of FIR No.6 of 02.09.2011, under Section 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 224 of the Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala, on the basis of the compromise.

Since the very factum of compromise has been disputed, therefore, the petition for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of the compromise is dismissed.
