The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.271 dated 12.10.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 29 of Insecticides Act, Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for over two months and investigation is over and challan has been filed and the case is triable by the Magistrate.

The State counsel urges that the petitioner is accused of selling spurious articles to farmers.
