This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. posing a challenge to order dated 31.07.2015, passed by the trial court accepting final report submitted by the investigating agency under section 173 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that proper notice ought to have been issued to the petitioner before accepting the report.

It appears, there was an accident on 17.9.2014. The car in question hit the motor cycle of the petitioner, due to which he fell down. Stand of the petitioner is that he suffered certain injuries in the accident. Investigating agency conducted a thorough probe and submitted an untraced report. Same has been accepted by the court below. According to the order passed, notice was issued to the complainant and same was

received back duly served. However, complainant failed to appear.
Under the circumstances, I find no ground to interfere in inherent jurisdiction of this court.

Dismissed.
