AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to take appropriate action on the representations/complaints (Annexure P-1 & P-2)).

Learned counsel has argued that at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide the representation/complaint (Annexure P-1) within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amrtisar Rural is directed to look into the representation/complaint (Annexures P-1) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
