MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for protection of his life and liberty by levelling allegations against one Balbir Singh, Numbardar of the village for having usurped the land of the Gram Panchayat. The matter was inquired into but the petitioner did not join the inquiry despite summons. It was also informed by the inquiry officer that he himself inquired into the complaint by said Balbir Singh, Numbardar and even after having come to know about the pendency of the inquiry the petitioner failed to associate himself with the same and now prays for a fair inquiry.

In the considered view of this Court the petitioner has no right to insist upon another inquiry once having himself failed to participate in the inquiry. FIR under the provisions of NDPS Act has been registered against the petitioner and in these circumstances it is very difficult to comment upon the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner and

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even for that purpose by respondent no.4. The petition is thus disposed of leaving the petitioner and respondent no.4 to their remedies in law. In case the petitioner faces any apprehension of his life or liberty he may approach the respondents who would be at liberty to take appropriate decision in the given set of circumstances. No further directions are required to be given.

Disposed of.
