SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.43 dated 18.04.2014, under Sections 382, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 14.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact petitioner had been given injuries by the complainant on 28.03.2014. Petitioner had approached the police for registration of a case against the complainant, but no case was registered against the complainant. Petitioner and his two brothers had been falsely involved in this case. Other two brothers of the petitioner were arrested and have since been released on regular bail. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. Even the motorcycle in question did not belong to the complainant.

Notice of motion for 22.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Sukhpal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 14.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
