The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide protection to the life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7 who relatives of the petitioner No.1.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 31.05.1992 as per copy of the matriculation certificate (Annexure P-1). Petitioner No.2 is also a major and his date of birth is 21.05.1992 as per the copy of matriculation certificate (Annexure P-2) and he is a partner in the computer solutions firm in the name of Duzis Solutions.

The marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 05.11.2015 according to Sikh rites in Guru Nanak Niwas Sahib Pind Karor Kalan, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali and a copy of the Marriage Certificate is attached as Annexure P-3 and photographs

of the marriage ceremony are attached as Annexures P-4. The petitioners belong to different religions. They are apprehensive that the private respondents would interfere in their married life and that their safety, life and liberty is at threat. The petitioners have made representation to respondent No.2 on 05.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) for the protection of their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the ***Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478***, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to look into the said issue upon the representation (Annexure P-5) made to respondent No.2 and take necessary action in accordance with law and provide protection, if required.
