On instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, it has been informed by the State counsel that two complaints, filed by Mandeep Singh and Balihar Singh respondent No.5 are pending inquiry and that the petitioner is required to join the said inquiry.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner is required for any inquiry, the provisions of Section 160 of Code of Criminal Procedure will be followed and a written notice will be issued to the petitioner requiring him to appear before the concerned police officials.

This order will remain operative for a period of one year and will be applicable only regarding the complaints of Balihar Singh and Mandeep Singh.

It is observed that in case the petitioner is required in future in any criminal case as accused it will be open to the petitioner to avail the legal remedy available to him by following the due process of law.
