SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.139 dated 02.10.2014 under Sections 15 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 13.11.2014.

*“Learned counsel for the
petitioner has submitted that the
petitioner is not the owner of the car in
question. Petitioner is not involved in
any other case under the Narcotic
Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act,
1985. Petitioner was not apprehended at
the spot.*

*Notice of motion for
20.01.2015.*

*In the meantime, in the event of
arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim
bail subject to the satisfaction of the
Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the
conditions envisaged under Section 438(2)
of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”*

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by
Assistant Sub Inspector Narinder Kumar has submitted
that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined
investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this
Court to the petitioner vide order dated 13.11.2014 is
made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
