1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 to transfer the investigation to some independent agency in case FIR No.105 dated 06.09.2015, Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur registered under Sections 304/201/34 IPC, on the ground that the death of her husband has not been fairly investigated.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation (Annexure P-4) before the SSP, Sangrur-respondent No.3 and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is

given to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and decide her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-4) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law expeditiously.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
