SNEH PRASHAR, J.

1. Ms. Mahima, AAG, Haryana, appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 has filed reply in the shape of affidavit of Ajit Singh, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police, Mujessar, Faridabad. It has been stated in the affidavit that SI Haripal of Police Station Saran, Faridabad was deputed for enquiry about the petitioners and it has been reported by him that none of the petitioners were residing at the address given in the petition. Statement of Sunder Singh s/o Mahilal resident of Radha complex were recorded during the enquiry. He stated that the petitioner No.2. Kamal Singh @ Sonu s/o Mahinder Singh was employed as driver on his vehicle but he had left the job about 2 years ago and thereafter his whereabouts were not known to him. The petitioners had also not made any representation to the Deputy Commissioner or to any authority of the police.

It is apparent from the reply filed on behalf of State that the petitioners had given their wrong addresses while filing the present petition. The

argument of learned counsel for the petitioner that the address mentioned was where the petitioners were residing at the time of filing of the petition is not tenable. It is clear from the reply of the State that they had not been residing at the given address at any point of time i.e. even at the time when the petition was filed. The petitioners have also not approached this Court to intimate change in their addresses, if any after the petition was instituted.

3. Thus, finding that the petitioners had not approached the Court with clean hands there appears no merit in the petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
