Quashing of the FIR No.179 dated 22.07.2014 under Sections 325, 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, Distrit Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 16.10.2014 (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

The FIR was registered on a statement made by Vinod Kumar-respondent No.2/complainant that on 14.07.2014, he came to know that Om Parkash son of Brij Lal etc. were irrigating the land under their possession. The matter was reported to the police, they took away their tractor and fan from the spot. In the night, at 11.30 PM, the complainant found Om Parkash son of Brij Lal, armed with kappa, Pawan Kumar son of Om Parkash armed with soti, Sanjay son of Ram Pratap, armed with kapa, Madan Lal son of Dharam Lal, were coming towards him and inflicted injuries upon him and in this

background the FIR was registered.

During the pendency of the investigation, the matter has been compromised by the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 13.11.2014, status report has been received from the District & Sessions Judge, Ferozepur and the statements of parties have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.179 dated 22.07.2014 under Sections 325, 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, Distrit Fazilka (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
