JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for directing the senior police functionaries to protect the life, liberty and the property of the petitioner and his family members from private respondents No. 6 and 7 and the SHO of Police Station Ajnala (respondent No. 8). The alleged harassment of respondents No. 6 to 8 is stated to be at the behest of the local M.P. in the background of the Public Interest Litigation filed by the petitioner regarding embezzlement of revenues of the State by the revenue officials.

Upon notice, reply dated 23.09.2014 on behalf of the DSP, Ajnala has been filed. In the reply, it is stated that on the allegations of the petitioner, as contained in the various applications filed by him, a thorough enquiry was got conducted wherein it is revealed that the allegations being levelled by the petitioner are found false.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties and keeping in view the contents of the reply, it is evident that no orders are required to be passed in the present case. However, if the petitioner still has any grievance, he is free to seek his remedy in accordance with law before the Courts of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
