Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 30.1.2015. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file Annexure-P-4. The photocopies of Middle Standard Examination certificates, showing the date of birth of both the petitioners have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 30.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

It comes out that the petitioners have moved a representation dated 30.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5) before Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, whereas the same should have been moved before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

In these circumstances, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 30.1.2015 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
