Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Attar Singh alleging that the petitioners had taken away the canter parked at dhabha to a distant place and had committed the theft of tyres.

The involvement of the petitioners will certainly be a debatable issue. Statement of complainant has already been recorded.

Learned State counsel informs that the petitioners are involved in other criminal cases of similar nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State counsel and I am of the opinion that the petitioners have been in custody w.e.f. 29.04.2015. The involvement of the petitioners, in similar other blind FIRs will certainly raise a debatable issue whether petitioners have been involved in all

the cases with an oblique motive or that they are habitual of committing such thefts.

Without expressing any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
