Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482
Cr.P.C. Seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to
protect the life and liberty against the illegal act of
threatening of killing the petitioner by respondents No.5 to 7.

Respondents No.5 to 7, have filed reply in the
form of affidavit, stating therein that the petitioner is a major
and she can go anywhere.

The petitioner has been produced by the officials

of Nari Niketan, in the Court today. The petitioner herself also stated at the bar that she wanted to marry with one Deepak.

Learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 7 has stated at the bar that they have no objection in the marriage of the petitioner with Deepak.

Since, the petitioner is a major and she can choose her own life and liberty, so she may be allowed to go anywhere, she wants.

Respondents No.5 to 7, shall be bound by their affidavits.

The Nari Niketan Authorities are directed to allow the petitioner to go anywhere she wants, since she is a major.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
