Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.147 dated 04.09.2014, under Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 14.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a widow and maintaining three minor children. FIR in question was a result of civil litigation pending between the petitioner and her brother-in-law. Complainant has lodged the FIR in question at the instance of the brother-in-law of the complainant.

Notice of motion for 22.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. She shall abide by the conditions

envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Baljinder Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 14.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
