Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act in a case arising out of FIR No.71 dated 18.08.2014, registered at Police Station Khanauri District Sangrur.

After registration of the FIR, challan has been presented on 18.11.2014 without the chemical examiner report.

Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh has informed this Court that the chemical examiner report is still awaited and the trial is now fixed for 31.01.2015. Recovery from the petitioner is 60 kgs. of poppy husk.

Counsel for the State has further informed that there is no other criminal case is pending against the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 18.08.2014.

Keeping in view the above facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular

bail till the chemical examiner report is received and thereafter he shall be at liberty to avail regular bail before the trial Court, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
