As per the allegations in the FIR, petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly, is attributed sword blow on the head of Prince. The injury attributed to the petitioner is not a grievous injury but injury Nos.6, 8 and 9, fractures on the person of Prince, have been found to be grievous.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.07.2014 and complainant having been examined, he can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM, Karnal.
