As per pleadings on record, the date of birth of the petitioner is 19.02.1993. It has been contended on behalf of the petitioner that private respondents No.4 to 9 i.e. her immediate relatives including parents and brothers wish to get her married to an aged person and that too, without her consent. Petitioner on the basis of such averments apprehends a threat to her life and personal liberty.

Without even ascertaining the correctness and averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala as regards her grievance. In the eventuality of any representation being preferred, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the same and thereafter to take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
