Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case where recovery of 20 kg heroin was effected from co-accused of the petitioner. Rashpal Singh made a disclosure statement that he and his co-accused had smuggled 59 packets of heroin from Pakistan with the help of BSF officials.

Recovery has been got effected by co-accused Rashpal Singh.

It is an admitted fact that no recovery was actually effected from the petitioner. Petitioner having been named as an accused by co-accused and recoveries having already been effected, his culpability in the crime would be a debatable issue during trial.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
