Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.44 dated 10.04.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 324, 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 13.11.2015:-

"Counsel for the petitioner submits that the knife blows are attributed to one Gurdev and not to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Chadwal accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Adjourned to 04.12.2015.

In the meanwhile, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the arresting officer, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Tehal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 13.11.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
