The present petition for protection appears to have been filed concealing the factum of FIR under Section 376 IPC having been registered prior to the date of filing of the petition.

It has been informed that petitioner No.1 has been granted concession of regular bail in the said case on the basis of statement made by petitioner No.2 before the Magistrate.

In view of subsequent events, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioners would be entitled to protection granted vide order dated 14.11.2014 in their individual capacity as citizen of India but not as a married couple as claimed by them. It is also directed that petitioner No.2 will not be forcibly taken into custody by any of the respondents as he is already on bail in the criminal case registered against him unless until any notice is issued to him granting him seven days time to avail the legal remedy available to him. So far as petitioner No.1 lady is

concerned, she would be entitled to enforce her right of life and liberty, in case, there is any threat to her from any of the respondents.
