The instant petition was preferred under section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R No.79 dated 25.8.2009 under sections 452, 323, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Dhanaula, District Barnala, on the basis of compromise which as per counsel had been entered into between the parties.

It so transpires that even though, parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court for recording of their statements on 25.5.2015 but such statements have not been recorded.

Even learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would candidly submit that the compromise as of date has not fructified.

Accordingly, present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is dismissed as not pressed.
