This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 65 dated 10.10.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 14.11.2014, the parties were directed to

appear before the learned CJM/Illaq Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of SDJM, Patti dated 18.12.2014 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the the parties have compromised the matter with their sweet will and without any pressure from any corner.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466**, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 65 dated 10.10.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
