Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.206 dated 10.06.2014, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Vide order dated 13.02.2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, interim relief was granted only as a concession as the petitioner had agreed to pay an amount of ₹2,00,000/- on 28.02.2015 to the complainant and rest of the amount in three installments of

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₹2,00,000/-, ₹2,00,000/- and ₹2,50,000/- to be paid on the 28th of the March, April and May, 2015, respectively.

The order dated 13.02.2015 has not been complied with.

In view of above, no ground for further extending the interim relief is made out.

Dismissed for non-compliance of order dated 13.02.2015.

Interim relief granted to the petitioner stands vacated.
