This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 156 dated 29.10.2011 under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report from the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise. This is a personal dispute which has been amicably settled.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised.

Affidavit of respondent No. 3-Harminder Singh has also placed on the record.

Learned State counsel has also stated at the bar that State has no objection for quashing the above said FIR on the basis of compromise.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stands quashed.
