Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 20.10.2015, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations levelled by the complainant Panches, petitioner while performing his duty is alleged to have wrongly mentioned their names as opposing the resolution dated 18.12.2013.

It was contended that after a period of two years, the FIR has been lodged with absolutely false averments which are not borne from the records. It is further submitted that the petitioner has since joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Ramphal, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 18.11.2015, is made absolute/confirmed.
