Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 183 dated 30.10.2014 registered under Sections 447, 511, 323, 336, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act at P.S. Sadar Jagraon District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Sukhdev Singh, states that in pursuance to order passed by this Court on 17.11.2014, petitioners have joined investigation on 24.3.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that compromise has also been effected between the parties and no recovery is to be

made in pursuance thereof.

In view of the above, interim order dated 17.11.2014 is made absolute.
