By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84, dated 04.09.2015, registered under Sections 307 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 18.11.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required

for custodial interrogation.

The learned counsel for the complainant opposes the bail application and states that there are specific allegations against the petitioners in the FIR.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
