This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No. 212 dated 27.09.2002 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the learned trial Court has allowed the composition of offences on the basis of compromise, therefore, the petitioners stand acquitted of the charges framed against them.
