JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 831 dated 11.07.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 326 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, District Panipat (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations in the FIR, the accused party including the present petitioner-Amit, armed with a country made pistol, had waylaid the complainant-Rajiv and inflicted injuries on his person. The only role attributed to the petitioner is that he was armed with a country made pistol.

It is contended that it is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioner himself received injuries. It is submitted that 16 stitches were given on the left side of the left nasal. Apart from the same, it is contended that the co-accused Parveen is attributed the role of firing by the country made pistol at the complainant,

which missed his person, has since been granted regular bail by the learned trial Court whereas co-accused Randhir @ Dhira has been granted regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 04.11.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Hem Raj, does not dispute the fact that the said Parveen and another co-accused Randhir @ Dhira have since been released on bail. It is not denied that the petitioner is in custody since 11.07.2015 and the investigations qua him are over.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment, custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.

Disposed of.
