The petitioner are seeking regular bail in FIR No. 339 dated 26.08.2014, registered under Sections 395, 397, 307, 506, 109, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injured and the complainant did not support the prosecution version. Learned counsel further states that the petitioners are in custody for over a year and and co-accused Raj Kumar and Remeshwar with similar allegations are on bail besides Paramjit Singh and Malkit.

The State counsel has opposed the bail application but does not dispute the fact that the complainant and injured have not supported the prosecution version.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners and as the trial will take long to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
