The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 257 dated 18.07.2014, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda under Section 420 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the proceedings under the Negotiable Instruments Act have been initiated against the complainant and the FIR has been registered against him relating to the same cheques. It was urged that the petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2014 and the trial is taking time and may be allowed bail.
