Report dated 22.7.2014 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Daljit Kaur @ Beero, Baldev Singh and Gurjant Singh as well as of complainant Binder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a civil dispute over money and since the parties are of the same very area and offences are not heinous in nature and that the compromise will go a long way to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.24 dated 22.1.2013 under Sections 420,506,120-B IPC Police Station, Jodhewal, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
