By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.145, dated 01.10.2015, registered under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 19.11.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
