Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 578, dated 20.11.2013 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 468, 471, 120-B and 212 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 65/66 of the Information Technology, Act, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

As per allegations, the petitioner alongwith other four co-accused had opened a bank account with a fake identity of Deepak Kapoor and thereafter by hacking the account of other customers got transferred money in the said account and subsequently withdrew the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the co-accused Naresh Gupta and Suyash Kumar have been granted bail by this Court.

Learned State Counsel submits that two other co-accused are proclaimed offenders, who have active participation in hacking the account with fake identity. He further submits that out of seventeen prosecution witnesses, sixteen witnesses have been examined and the evidence of the testimony of 17th witness is fixed for today.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that the trial is at the fag end, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
