Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sukhvir Singh in case FIR No.40 dated 4.3.2015 for offence punishable under Section 323, 324, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station Machhiwara Police, District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations the petitioner along with co-accused waylaid the complainant Amarjit Singh and inflicted injuries upon him. The role attributed to the petitioner is that he inflicted two *gandasa* blows which landed on the right wrist and chest of the complainant and one of the injuries has been declared grievous in nature.

It is contended that there is a civil dispute between the parties and petitioner who is M.A. Student has been falsely implicated.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Mohan Lal submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 19th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
