Report dated 17.12.2014 sent by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Amarjit as well as of complainants Raj Kumar and Sapna Kumari @ Komal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the dispute between the parties is of personal life of a girl and boy, who have already got married and that this compromise will go a long way to settle their matrimonial life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.36 dated 01.03.2014 under Sections 363, 366 IPC registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
