The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.144 dated 23.08.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 333, 353, 186, 341, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and states that the complainant LHC Dhanpati inflicted injury to Smt. Suman Devi who is in advance stage of pregnancy. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that co-accused has already been admitted to bail by learned Sessions Judge, Kaithal.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner along with other co-accused gave the beatings to five police

officials and torn their uniforms. The learned State counsel has furnished the chart which shows the total 24 injuries suffered by all the police officials and the same is taken on record and opposes the bail.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Keeping in view the seriousness of offence and the injuries suffered by the petitioner, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
