LISA GILL, J.

The petitioners prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 151 dated 06.11.2014 registered under Sections 447, 511, 379, 506 IPC at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

On 20.11.2014, this matter had been placed before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on the request of the parties. Learned counsel for the parties submits that pursuant thereto, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties though not at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The petitioners have since joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh confirms and verifies that the petitioners have indeed joined investigation though it is submitted that there is no information

regarding the settlement between the parties with the police authorities.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the complainant - Bahadur Singh has settled the matter with the petitioners as well as other co-accused, who have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court on 16.01.2015.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Order dated 20.11.2014 is made absolute.
