The petitioner is seeking interim bail in FIR No. 126 dated 23.08.2013, registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act at Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is suffering from Polio Residual Paralysis of both lower limbs and Medical Certificate (Annexure P-2) has been given by the Doctor that the patient require multiple surgeries for correction of deformities and the interim bail may be allowed.

Learned State counsel has filed reply and also opinion taken from the Professor and Head of the Department of Orthopaedics. According to which, the petitioner is having this

problem since childhood and there is no urgency of surgery. As per the report, the patient require Limb lengthening on the right side. It has also been reported that there is no urgency.

In view of above, no case for interim bail is made out. The petition is dismissed. However, the State would provide all medical facilities and treatment which can be made available to the petitioner.
