ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 2 dated 02.01.2015, registered under Section 420 IPC, Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken Rs.7 lacs from Sewa Singh for getting their children recruited in the Jail Department, Punjab. The payment is said to have been made at his house. The case was registered after an inquiry held by ACP, Ludhiana.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that no date or year is mentioned in the FIR. Counsel for the petitioner has stated that he has a telephone recording which reveals that threats were being given to the petitioner. It was urged that there were family disputes and a false FIR had been registered.

The petitioner had been asked to join the investigation and he has done so.

Recovery has not been effected. The petitioner did not hand-over any recording to the police. After an inquiry by the ACP, the FIR had been registered. Custodial interrogation is necessary. The allegations are grave No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
