INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners Gurpreet Singh and Mahabir Singh have preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.74 dated 04.06.2014, registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested this bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, the injuries attributed to petitioner No.1 Gurpreet Singh are simple injuries whereas grievous injuries are attributed to petitioner No.2 Mahabir Singh. Both the petitioners are stated to be in custody since 06.07.2014. Challan has already been presented and the trial is going on and it will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody furthermore.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 35,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
