FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 16.04.2015 of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran has been received on the basis of statements of Injured Rajwinder Kaur, Injured Sawinder Singh, Complainant Gurmukh Singh as well as accused persons namely Ranjit Singh, Sukhdev Singh, Gurdev Singh, Iqbal Singh and Bakhshish Singh, whereby the above said parties have compromised the matter at the appellate stage.

Keeping in view that the parties belong to the same very village and this compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for betterment of their future life and will put an end to hostility and animosity, and in the light of law laid down by a Division Bench of this Court in '**Sube Singh and another v. State of Haryana and another**' **2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 102**, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 25.09.2013 passed by the trial Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tarn Taran convicting the present accused before this Court, is hereby set aside along with all consequences thereof. However it is made clear that this order shall not favour the case of the accused who are absconding.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
