The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.181 dated 15.7.2015, registered under Sections 420, 218, 467, 468, 471, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 20.11.2015.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner never deposited the amount collected from the complainant. However, he states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
