ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 76 dated 03.09.2015 registered at Police Station Jodhan, Ludhiana under Sections 323, 341, 294, 506, 148, 149 IPC and later on added Section 308 IPC.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he has given base ball blow on the head of the injured. The injury was declared dangerous to life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that injury is simple and the injured did not go to the Government Hospital but instead went to a hospital which was far and two reports have been made which are entirely different and in one of the report the injury is stated to be simple and blunt and in the other injury No. 12 is reported to be dangerous to life.

Perusal of the two reports placed on record by the petitioner show that opinion was given by the Doctor after going through the CT Scan . The MLR shows that there are several injuries

which are behind the right ear. There was bleeding from the nose. There was fracture of the right temporal bone. The record also reveals that two people were injured. There are 12 injuries on one person and 7 injuries on the other.

The allegations are serious. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
