JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.212 dated 25.06.2010, under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Farkpur, District Yamunanagar, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR, on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have been entered into compromise without any fear, undue pressure or coercion and there is now no misunderstanding and ill will between the parties to the litigation. Even otherwise, the matter involved is matrimonial in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

It is pretty settled that compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

So, In view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, **"Kulwinder Singh & others vs. State of Punjab & others" 2007**

(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of

law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.212 dated 25.06.2010, under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Farkpur, District Yamunanagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
