The petitioner has been in custody from 20.07.2015. Co-accused of the petitioner have been granted concession of bail by this Court. It is an admitted fact that nothing has been recovered from the petitioner though the allegation in the FIR against the petitioner is that he is a member of a gang indulging in extorting money by posing as police officials and threatening the people to implicate in cases under NDPS Act.

Taking into consideration the nature of the vague allegations and no recovery having been made from the petitioner, he can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
